



Note to the students

Subject: Transport and access to school sites from September 2017

Owing to the increasing number of students and the increasingly limited parking area, I have come to the decision to limit vehicle access to the sites in Alès because the car park capacity reserved for you will be drastically reduced. I would thus like Croupillac and Clavières sites to become pedestrian zones as much as possible. As a result, please note that access to the school car park with private vehicles will be strictly forbidden at Croupillac (Louis Leprince-Ringuet) and exclusively authorized to a few carpooling vehicles at Clavières.

Because the parking facilities are limited outside the school, I am asking you to commit yourself to any other means of transportation be it public transit, walking or cycling. Authorized access will be granted to a very limited number of vehicles that carpool and will be strictly enforced. The police force will issue parking fines for any vehicle incorrectly parked on the street and that has not respected the rules.

This strong commitment will also contribute to pollution control, reduce road risks, respect the environment and the peacefulness of the neighbours and everyone will benefit from this.

In order to help you use this ecological means of transportation, arrangements have been made in cooperation with the Town Council of Alès and a transport company. Bicycle parking areas will be significantly expanded as early as September. Regular road work on bicycle paths between the MDE, the school and the town centre will be carried out several times a year. Frequent buses with optimum schedules run from the MDE, to the school and to the train station.

The enclosed brochure indicates several routes and time schedules. In support of this new project, kindly sign the letter of commitment included in your registration file.

I am counting on your commitment.
